EDUCATIONAL SEMINAR!

The Manitoba Association of Parliamentarians (MAP) a constituent division of the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF PARLIAMENTARIANS[®] is holding an all-day parliamentary procedure workshop on Saturday, November 3rd 2013, from 9:15 AM to 3:30 PM, at the Clarion Hotel, 1445 Portage Ave, Winnipeg, Manitoba.

This educational session, called: *“MOTIONS SIMPLIFIED; one at a time”*, is designed for people seeking more information about proper meeting procedures. The seminar will be helpful for members of clubs, charities, homeowner associations, and/or any other type of non-profit organization that holds regular meetings.

Motions are the mechanism used in parliamentary procedure to get things done! Every action requested by a member will start with some kind of motion and debate is focused on the merits and weakness of each motion. Since some things are more important than others, and some things are more immediately pressing than others, it is important that motions be given priority in a systematic manner.

Understanding the different classes of motions is critical to understanding the orderly processing of decisions in a meeting. This seminar will create a systemic look at the variety of motions by considering the structure under which they are arranged. Then attendees will test their skills with games, because learning parliamentary procedure can be fun as well as educational.

Skilled coaches will help attendees to fit all the pieces together. The puzzle solved, attendees will understand exactly how motions help the members accomplish what they have come to the meeting to do, and how Rules of Order help an assembly to arrive at the will of those attending the meeting.
