# PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO NAP BYLAWS TO ELIMINATE DISTRICT CONFERENCES AND RENAME DISTRICT DIRECTORS

**PROPOSERS' NOTE:** Amendments 1 through 1.5 are part of a single plan and should be considered together. The crux of the plan is contained in Amendment 1 and its conforming amendments. While Amendments 1.1 through 1.5 are not, strictly speaking, "conforming amendments" as defined in RONR, they are necessary for proper implementation the implementation of Amendment 1.

**AMENDMENT 1—REDEFINE DISTRICTS** Amend Article IV, Divisions, Section 2, Districts, by striking Subsections A through C and inserting the following new subsections A & B, with the proviso that all persons elected as district directors in accordance with the current provisions of this section shall serve as district liaisons for the 2019-2021 biennium:

- **A. District Liaison.** There shall be a liaison for each district. District liaisons shall be registered or professional registered members who have their principal residence in the district at the time of appointment.
- **B. Duties of the District Liaisons.** The district liaison shall:
  - 1. promote NAP programs through associations and unchartered states, provinces, or countries;
  - 2. assist in the organization of associations and units within the district;
  - 3. encourage states, provinces, and countries to conduct classes for preparation for membership and assist them in their organization;
  - 4. promote educational programs for the general public especially in unchartered areas;
  - 5. appoint, with the approval of the NAP Board of Directors, a chairman of an unchartered state, province, or country within the district in accordance with Article IV, Section 4A; and
  - 6. perform such other duties as may be designated in these bylaws or as directed by the NAP Board of Directors or the NAP President.

- 4. Districts may adopt special rules of order and standing rules for the conduct of business at district conferences provided they do not conflict with these bylaws.
- **B. District Director.** There shall be a director for each district.
  - 1. District directors shall be registered or professional registered members who have their principal residence in the district at the time of election and who are entitled to vote at the district conference at which they are elected in accordance with Article IV, Section 8B1.
  - 2. Each district shall adopt, at a conference, procedures for the election of a district director. The election shall

There shall be a director liaison for each district.

District directors liaisons shall be registered or professional registered members who have their principal residence in the district at the time of appointment election and who are entitled to vote at the district conference at which they are elected in accordance with Article IV, Section 8B1.
- 2. Each district shall adopt, at a conference, procedures

- **C. Duties of the District Director.** The district director shall:
  - 1. promote NAP programs through associations and unchartered states, provinces, or countries;
  - 2. assist in the organization of associations and units within the district;
  - encourage states, provinces, and countries to conduct classes for preparation for membership and assist them in their organization;
  - 4. preside at the district conference;

- for the election of a district director. The election shall be completed before the opening of the NAP convention.
- 3. District directors shall assume office at the close of the NAP convention and serve until the close of the next convention or until their successors assume office.
- 4. District directors shall serve for no more than two terms consecutively and may serve again after being out of office for at least one term.
- 5. A vacancy in the office of district director shall be filled for the unexpired term by a special committee comprised of the association presidents in that district. The special committee shall be authorized to meet by teleconference at the call of any two of its members with at least three days' notice. If the special committee fails to elect a new district director within sixty days after the vacancy, the vacancy may be filled by the NAP Board of Directors.
- C. B. Duties of the District
  Director Liaison. The district
  director-liaison shall:
  - 1. promote NAP programs through associations and unchartered states, provinces, or countries;
  - assist in the organization of associations and units within the district;
  - 3. encourage states, provinces, and countries to conduct classes for preparation for membership and assist them in their organization;

- 5. promote educational programs for the general public especially in unchartered areas;
- 6. appoint, with the approval of the NAP Board of Directors, a chairman of an unchartered state, province, or country within the district in accordance with Article IV. Section 4A; and
- perform such other duties as may be designated in these bylaws or as directed by the NAP Board of Directors or the NAP President.

- 4. preside at the district conference:
- 5. promote educational programs for the general public especially in unchartered areas;
- 6. 5. appoint, with the approval of the NAP Board of Directors, a chairman of an unchartered state, province, or country within the district in accordance with Article IV, Section 4A; and
- 7. <u>6.</u> perform such other duties as may be designated in these bylaws or as directed by the NAP Board of Directors or the NAP President.

**PROVISO:** All persons elected as district directors in accordance with the current provisions of this section shall serve as district liaisons for the 2019-2021 biennium.

**CONFORMING AMENDMENTS:** At all locations where "district director" appears, strike "director and insert "liaison."

**PROPOSED BY:** To be determined

**RATIONALE:** The districts, as currently structured, have outlived their purpose. District conferences generally are sparsely attended, especially when held in the same year as the NAP biennial convention. The title "director" is no longer apropos, since (except for the two elected from among the eight) the district directors no longer serve on the NAP Board of Directors. Retaining the districts as geographical divisions, changing the titles of the district directors to district liaisons (or something similar), and eliminating the requirement of a district conference, will allow the districts to continue serving the function of providing a resource for the assigned associations, without having to plan for and conduct a sparsely attended conference.

**AMENDMENT 1.1—DROP DISTRICT MEMBERSHIP:** Amend Article III, Members, Section 1, Classification, Subsection C, Membership in Districts, Associations, and Units, by striking "districts" each place it appears, and adjusting punctuation as needed.

**AMENDMENT 1.2—DROP CRITERIA FOR DISTRICT MEMBERSHIP:** Amend Article IV, Divisions, Section 8, Section 8. Membership in Districts, Associations, and Units, Subsection B, Criteria, by striking Paragraph 1 and renumbering the succeeding paragraphs.

# **Current Wording**

#### B. Criteria.

- 1. A member of NAP, who is registered as in attendance, has paid the appropriate registration fee, and meets either of the following requirements may vote at the district conference:
  - a) primary member of an association in the district; or
  - b) member whose principal residence is in an unchartered state or province in the district and who is not a primary member of any association.
- 2. A member of NAP whose principal residence is in a state or province with an association shall belong to at least one association which may be a different association than that of the state or province in which the member resides. A member of NAP may belong to any number of associations. A member of NAP whose principal residence is in an unchartered state or province shall not be required to belong to an association
- 3. A member of NAP may belong to any number of units. A member of NAP who is a member of a unit shall be a member of the association, if any, with which the unit is affiliated.

#### B. Criteria.

- 1. A member of NAP, who is registered as in attendance, has paid the appropriate registration fee, and meets either of the following requirements may vote at the district conference:

  a) primary member of an
  - association in the district; or
  - b) member whose principal residence is in an unchartered state or province in the district and who is not a primary member of any association.
- 2.-1. A member of NAP whose principal residence is in a state or province with an association shall belong to at least one association which may be a different association than that of the state or province in which the member resides. A member of NAP may belong to any number of associations. A member of NAP whose principal residence is in an unchartered state or province shall not be required to belong to an association
- 3.2. A member of NAP may belong to any number of units. A member of NAP who is a member of a unit shall be a member of the association, if any, with which the unit is affiliated.

#### B. Criteria.

- 1. A member of NAP whose principal residence is in a state or province with an association shall belong to at least one association which may be a different association than that of the state or province in which the member resides. A member of NAP may belong to any number of associations. A member of NAP whose principal residence is in an unchartered state or province shall not be required to belong to an association
- 2. A member of NAP may belong to any number of units. A member of NAP who is a member of a unit shall be a member of the association, if any, with which the unit is affiliated.

**CONFORMING AMENDMENT:** In the title for Article IV, Section 8, strike "Divisions" and the comma after "Associations."
